Kvarner



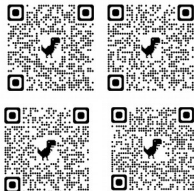
Where a sun-bathed Riviera can be easily replaced with a fresh mountain air of Gorski Kotar.

Once an endless blue Pannonian sea, today it glistens in gold and green.

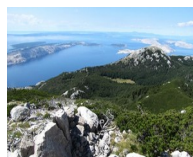
